You will learn the parts of the sewing machine, the different sewing tools and how they are used and sewing terms. You will practice sewing basic stitches and finishing stitches. You will learn how to cut out a pattern and complete a simple pillow case or simple table runner, your choice.

#### ***Supplies to bring to class:***

Sewing machine in working order  
Scissors  
Tape measure  
Pins  
Seam ripper  
45" wide cotton fabric or flannel fabric for pillow case (prewash fabric)  
.875 yard for body  
.25 yard for top band  
3" for piping  
Matching thread  
45" wide cotton fabric for table runner (prewash fabric)  
.625 yard for backing and front edge  
.334 yard for center

### **Beginning Quilting**

With the use of a rotary cutter, rotary mat and a straight edge ruler you will create a baby size blanket by cutting strips from 3 coordinating fabric choices using the Rail Fence pattern. Once pieced together you will join together the top, batting and backing to complete the quilt.

#### ***Supplies to bring to class:***

Sewing machine in working order  
Rotary cutter  
Rotary mat ( I have extra mat's if you need to use one of mine)  
Straight edge ruler - 24" long  
Pins  
Seam ripper  
Scissors  
3 coordinating fabrics -- 100% cotton or flannel works best  
.667 yards of each -- 2 prints and 1 solid color  
1 ¼ yard for backing -- this can be one of your original print choices  
Please prewash fabric before class  
1 ¼ yard of batting -- light weight polyester will make it fluffier  
Matching thread  
Matching color Pearl Cotton floss to tie the quilt together  
Don't forget a brown bag lunch
